# Salt stockpiled ready for winter

Salt stocks have swelled to 16,000 tonnes as Surrey County Council prepares to tackle ice and snow this win-

The stockpile is double the salt needed in an average Surrey winter and 60% more than was used to keep the county moving last season.

The huge heap is also more than enough to see Surrey through a winter similar to 2010/11, which gripped Britain with the worst weather for more than 30 years.

John Furey, Surrey County Council's Cabinet Member for Transport and Environment, said: "We have more than enough salt to see us through an average winter, with enough spare to deal with bouts of very severe weather. On top of this, our



The Police Area Returning Officer will announce the final result and the winning candidate in Guildford on Friday 16th November.






Surrey County Council's winter operation in action.











#### Tandridge residents send more to be recycled than to landfill

In the second week of the new recycling and waste service Tandridge residents sent more to be recycled than to landfill for the first time, increasing recycling rates to more than 50%.

The figures for the second week were:

- Almost 58 tonnes of food waste were collected, diverted from landfill and will be recycled into fertiliser and used to create electricity for people's homes;
- Almost 165 tonnes of mixed recycling were collected, diverted from landfill and sent to be recycled into new and useful products including new tins and cans, new paper and cardboard products and new plastic containers:
- Just under 191 tonnes of general waste were collected and sent to landfill. Councillor Tony Elias, Chairman of the Community Services Committee, which is responsible for the new recycling and waste service, said: "A big thank you to

our residents for using the new service – we are expecting these recycling rates to increase and landfill rates to go down."

The Recycling Team is reminding residents to:

- Put all their food waste, recycling or general waste out for collection by 6am on their collection day;
- Put their food waste and recycling at the edge of their property, general waste is collected from between the back door and the edge of property;
- Only use compostable bags in the food caddies – a list of local suppliers is available on www.tandridge.gov.uk/bags. Local shops supplying compostable food caddy bags can be added to this list by contacting the Council.

Anyone not sure about their collection days or dates can look them up on www.tandridge.gov.uk/collectiondates.

### Plans revealed for extension to **Upper Warling**ham Station car park

On Monday 8th October, Andrew Latimer, the Implementation Project Manager for Southern Railway, gave a presentation to Whyte-leafe Village Council about the forthcoming extension to Upper Warlingham Station car park.

The car park currently has 155 spaces and this number will increase to 245 in the New Year, thanks to the addition of 90 new spaces. An upper level to the existing car park will be constructed accessed by a single ramp. 

#### Chaldon Parish Councillor, Roger Davies, stands down

Councillor Roger Davies has decided to leave the Council after spending over a decade poring over planning applications, helping to keep Chaldon's footpaths in good shape, leading on two village plans and guiding the Village Council to Quality Council status in 2007. He chaired the Council with great distinction between 2004 and 2011.

Recently he has fought doggedly to improve safety for children attending St Peter and St Paul School by championing the pavement extension in Rook Lane. The project is due to start later this month.

His wife, Linda, recalls that when discussions were taking place in 2000 about the Chaldon Association taking a new shape as the Chaldon Parish Council, Roger had been the only member to oppose the move but had said "I had better just join it to see what's going on".

From then on he has spent a large part of his life in local government and community affairs, always with the interests of Chaldon at the heart of his activities.

Looking back Roger said: "The highlights for me were being one of the first three councillors in a brand new council, the pride of being given the Quality Council award by the Lord Lieutenant of Surrey and the recognition it gave Chaldon. Also high on the list are our first Village Plan 2007-2011 and the progress made to enact it and the Burial Ground Project when we restored the resting place of former patients of St Lawrence's Hospital and ultimately took it over from the NHS in 2011. Throughout my time as a councillor I have always been aware of our special position as a non-party-political council focused solely on the needs and concerns of Chaldon and I hope that will continue. I would encourage local people to get involved in the Village Council as though we have limited powers, the Council is re-

spected by both the District and County Councils and can influence the actions of its more powerful partners." Roger has been a very active 'hands-on' councillor in the old tradition who has led from the front and has been a dependable colleague. We will miss him greatly and hope that he will enjoy his retirement tending his garden, cycling and walking with Linda and having fun with his grand children.

Year 12 student, Ryan Bridge said: "I didn't realise it happened so much on our very own doorstep."

Academy Head Girl, Sophie Hack, suggested that Stop the Traffik and the government could make more use

of social media to raise awareness amongst young people and this media could also be used to help fundraise to support victims.

Students at Oasis Academy Coulsdon have raised more than £3.000 over a three year period for Stop the Traffik and Jenny Butcher, Assistant Head of Sixth Form who coordinates STT fundraising told Mr Timpson that the money raised by the Academy has helped provide an education for two young trafficking victims in Zimbabwe. Timpson praised the Academy students for their creative fundraising ideas and said that Academy staff had been 'fantastic' in embedding support.

He said: "This is something that we would encourage all schools to take a direct interest in. Everyone should work together so that if someone is a victim immediate action is taken and support given. In the government, we now have a proper strategy and we regularly review our progress to make sure we are fulfilling our aims."


# New canteen for de Stafford School



It worked brilliantly last year, so fingers crossed! I also placed bags of un-opened horse manure on some very large dahlias that I left in the garden. These acted as a duvet, and were in just the right place in early summer to bulk up the soil so that it was nice and rich - just what dahlias love! True, the bags do not look good. So having a large garden, the ones out of sight are more likely to get treated this way.

The garden is still ablaze with colour, these are some of my favourites:-

Cyclamen Hederifolium. They are smaller than the persicum which are everywhere at this time of year but are not hardy.

Aster(Michaelmas Daisy), my favourite is Aster Frikartii Monch which starts flowering in July and is still beautiful.

Schizostylis Coccinea, like a small gladioli, that glows through October and November.

Liriope Muscari - they have evergreen grassy leaves, and produce lilac grape hyacinth type flowers, a tidy, easy plant that should be used more often.

The poisonous Monkshood, their rich blue flowers are stunning amongst the tall grasses, which are interspersed with the self-seeding Verbena Bonariensis.

All we need now is some late sunshine!






