## Community rallies to support flood victims

Businesses and residents in Whyteleafe whose properties lie close to the route of the Bourne River are reeling from the effects of the river finally bursting its banks following weeks of heavy rain.

The Environment Agency had issued a flood alert for the Bourne in mid-January, warning people to prepare for possible flooding. Despite the efforts of the local council and the Environment Agency to clear culverts and gullies close to the Bourne, the level of the groundwater-fed river continued to rise, finally flooding the area in the first week of February. Within a very short time the A22

in Whyteleafe had to be closed to traffic and back gardens and a number of houses were flooded along with several businesses. To make matters worse, raw sewerage burst through manhole covers to mix with the flood water.

Godstone Road resident, Robert Baynham, said: "I am lucky because only my garden is flooded, not my house, but there is sewerage floating around in my garden and we cannot flush the toilet when we need to. Thames Water have delivered Portaloos for us to use but that's not much fun in the middle of the night."

Other families have had to find temporary accommodation after evacuating their flooded properties

In an effort to alleviate the immediate distress caused to those residents affected by the flood, community leaders in Whyteleafe launched the 'Whyteleafe Flood Appeal'.

The vicar of St. Luke's Church, Reverend Tim Goode, said: "Local people can see the suffering caused by the floods but feel powerless to help in these situations. Making a donation will not just help in a practical sense – it will also send out a strong message to the victims of the flooding that their community cares about them. We can act now to do something to help them."

#### **Community in** shock following tragic death of 14 year-old Breck **Bednar**

On Sunday 23rd February the bells of St. John's Church in Caterham Valley and St. Mary's Church in Caterhamon-the-HII were rung halfmuffled and prayers were said for 14 year-old Breck Bednar who was stabbed to death on Monday 17th February.

Breck had travelled by train to meet an 18 year-old stranger in Grays in Essex that he had met over the internet. Breck had told his parents he would be staying with a friend overniaht.

Hours after he arrived, Breck was found dead at the flat by paramedics. He had been stabbed in the neck.

Breck was a Year 10 student at St. Bede's School in Redhill. He lived in Caterham with his parents Barry Bednar and Lorin LaFave and three younger siblings.

In a statement his parents said: "Our family is devastated by the loss of our beloved Breck David LaFave Bednar. He was a kind, intelligent, thoughtful boy with a good sense of humour and was a dedicated student at St Bede's School in Redhill and extremely gifted in computing, electronics, and engineering. Breck was a member of the Air Cadets with the 135 Squadron

#### Wildlife Aid team rescues trapped deer

A young roe deer trapped in an enclosure by Kenley Airfield since spring last year has finally been freed, much to the relief of local residents.

The deer had been trapped close to Victor Beamish Avenue in Caterham-on-the-Hill and seemed unable to escape. At the end of January, local residents concerned for the animal's welfare called the Surrey Wildlife Trust who recommended consulting the Wildlife Aid Foundation based in Leatherhead. After first assessing the situation, the decision was made to try to capture the young female deer and return her to the wild.

Wildlife Aid worker David Gooden and his team were concerned that the deer may injure herself on the high security fencing during the rescue attempt, but as she negotiated a ditch the

crew were able to catch her and safely secure her fore and hind legs to avoid injury. She was then put in a sleeping bag, carried to a vehicle and transported to Kenley Common where she was released.

David Gooden said: "After we released the deer she ran a short way off then stopped and looked back at us before walking away."

#### Blue plaque unveiled to commemorate former Soldiers' Home.

On Saturday 22nd February the unveiling of the Bourne Society's 30th blue plaque took place outside the Raja Tandoori at 4 High Street, Caterham-on-the-Hill. latest plaque commemorates the Soldiers' Home that occupied the building from 1898 until circa 1950.

Before the unveiling, Bourne Roger Society President, Packham, explained the history of the Soldiers' Home. He also described the grand ceremony that took place at its official opening on Friday October 28th, 1898 when the ceremony was performed by Lord Roberts of Kandahar V.C., the Commander-in-Chief in Ireland.

The unveiling of the blue plaque was performed by Caterham resident, Mr John Barnes, who was born in the building in 1944. His parents lived there because his father, Charles Barnes, was the last Superintendent of the Soldiers' Home.

## Diary of a **Plantaholic**

With sogginess still prevailing, I find it hard to think that Spring really is on its way, yet the birds are singing and the bulbs are showing, and the beautiful snowdrops are fully out.

Dry days have seen Geoff trying to finish trimming the hedges, before the birds start nesting.

I have been concentrating on clearing the beds for my hardy annual seeds. Poppies, Clarkia and Love-in-a-Mist are favourites. They cope with cool spells, but my half-hardy seeds won't be sown till mid-March, and will have the protection of a propagator.

Nets will need to be removed from the pond shortly, as the frogs have hardly hibernated this year. I hope they are hungry, as there should be plenty of slugs for them! Do start protecting the young shoots of plants like Delphiniums and Lupins and any other tender growth.

pruning the Roses, and lightly trimming Clematis, especially if they are early flowering, as I don't want to cut off any flower buds. Roses are tougher and fairly forgiving, but I try to remove any dead or diseased stems, and any that are crossing and congested. I cut back to outward-facing buds.

Last year I fed both Roses and Clematis with long-life granules and well rotted manure. The granules last six months and are so easy to apply at this time of year. My giant 'Skyscraper' Lillies have been planted in large pots in situ. This year I will make sure I can get to them easily (so I can squash lily beetles!).


#### VIP guests join de Stafford students to celebrate GCSE success

Students at de Stafford School in Caterham were surprised to see their head teacher, Mr Jeremy Garner, navigating his way around the school in a wheelchair recently. Mr Garner was using the wheelchair, kindly loaned to him by Titan Mobility in Caterham, to help one of his pupils, Megan Downs, raise awareness of the issues faced by wheelchair users. Megan was born with a very rare condition called Arthrogryposis Multiplex Congenita which inhibits the movement of her limbs, so Megan spends much of her time in a wheelchair.

Megan said: "As part of our Citizenship Project I had to choose something to campaign about so I chose the issues faced by wheelchair users. Mr Garner kindly agreed to spend some time in a wheelchair to see for himself the challenges we face and to get the attention of the rest of the school.

"I thnk it is very important that disabled people are seen as human beings, and not just nuisances getting in the way."

Describing the experience, Mr Garner said: "The students were very concerned to see me in the wheelchair when Megan and I popped in to their classrooms. One of the biggest things for me was the physicality of it - my arms are really hurting from pushing the wheels!

"The students can see that Megan doesn't make a fuss. She has such a positive outlook in life and is such an ambassador - she confronts challenges head on."

Megan said: "I have bad days sometimes but the school has been brilliant at accommodating my needs over the last five years. I am grateful to Mr Garner for helping me with my awareness campaign today."



Whyteleafe businesses were also badly affected by flood water and the closure of the A22. Although some businesses were able to remain open or re-open, their customers had difficulty reaching them.

Trevor Slaughter of Wraysbury Tyres said: "We had to close when the flood first came because we lost power, but we have managed to reopen one of our four workshops now. Instead of our customers coming to us, we are going to them so that we can keep the business ticking over until things get back to normal."

On Friday 21st February Sam Gyimah MP and the Chief Executive of Tandridge District Council, Louise Round, met local business owners in the BP garage in Whyteleafe. After hearing the views of the business owners about how they felt the situation could have been handled better by the different agencies, Louise Round said: "I will guarantee we will co-ordinate a review

of this situation and get a clear plan for the future should this happen again. We need to have Thames Water, Surrey County Council, Tandridge District Council, the Environment Agency and local businesses all round the table."

Sam Gyimah also expressed his support, saying he would do all he could to ensure business owners received financial assistance from the government.







## A 'royal' dining experience at Dewan-E-Am

The name 'Dewan-E-Am' means 'The dining room of royalty' which will give some indication of the quality of service diners can expect when they visit this popular Indian restaurant in Caterham-on-the-Hill. Located just along the road from Tesco at 188 Coulsdon Road, the restaurant is easy to find with ample parking nearby. When I visited recently on a Saturday evening with my friend Sally, the restaurant soon became busy with regular customers who were greeted warmly by restaurant owner Sam Chouldary.

As we nibbled on some lovely warm papadams we perused the menu, trying to decide whether or not to order a starter or have an extra side dish with our main courses instead. The 'Special Platter' starter caught our eye, so we decided to order one to share as an appetiser. The dish consisted of tender pieces of Chicken Tikka, Lamb Tikka and a Sheekh Kebab, just the right amount for us to share, beautifully presented

with a drizzle of sauce and salad

garnish. For our main courses I chose the Chicken Surprise and Sally chose one of the Dewan-E-Am Specialities, Lamb Korai. We ordered a portion of Mushroom Pilau Rice and a Peshwari Nan bread to share, to go with our meat dishes.

Sally's Lamb Korai was cooked with hot fresh garlic, chilli and a selection of spices with onion and green herbs. It was not too spicy and Sally said that it made a wonderful change from the creamy curries she normally chooses. My Chicken Surprise was a lovely mild Chicken Bhuna but you will have to order the dish yourself to find out what the added surprise is! Both our main courses had

generous servings of meat. The excellent service and food accompanied by a delicious bottle of Chardonnay ensured a very enjoyable evening and the

very enjoyable evening and the quantity of food we ordered was just right. The prices are very reasonable too. For example Sally's Lamb Korai was £6.10 and the Mushroom Pilau Rice we shared was just £2.75. Sam encouraged us to try

#### Nature Notes

The magpie rhyme has run short. There are 22 chalkand-ebony chatterers milling about the field's edge, chuckling from trees or scavenging for grubs. It is the winter social season, and these supersized flocks allow unpaired magpies to find new mates. But on the other side of the meadow, huddled into a bare hedgerow still damp with January's record-breaking rain, a single fox awakes. He ambles away from his dripping shelter. He doesn't approach the magpie flock, but I've no doubt that he's noticed - they don't miss much.

Fox and magpie: there is something special about seeing them together, our two most intelligent wild creatures subtly vying like masters at chess. Like ravens following wolves in the Canadian forests, magpies seem irresistibly drawn to the spectacle of a fox on the move - a black-andwhite train that ever grows, perching on fence-posts, overhead. Of swooping

course magpies will steal scraps from whatever prey their fox manages to catch, but their interest is far more than that - curiosity at a potential danger and rival, and perhaps even amusement. Like crows and ravens, magpies have a well-documented playful streak, and sometimes it's hard to judge if they're pecking a fox's brush to hassle them away or just in jest.

But it's not always negative for the fox. They can show amazing tolerance to a magpie that removes moulting fur during spring. Their relationship is a rivalry, but one with room for an occasional truce.


