Sam Gyimah MP responds to Local **Plan Consultation**

Sam Gyimah MP has urged Tandridge District Council to engage fully with the concerns of communities over possible development set out in its initial local plan consultation.

In a formal response to the consultation, Mr Gyimah acknowledged the difficulties of local planning, but stressed the need for full weight to be given to local constraints, including the Green Belt, transport infrastructure and the threat of floodina.

The East Surrey MP urged the Council to demonstrate that "residents have been listened to, not presented with a fait accompli" and ensure residents would receive "clear and intelligible explanations" for decisions moving forward.

Diary of a **Plantaholic**

by Sue Baines

This is my favourite time of year. Everything is springing into life, and the plants are definitely looking more alive than dead, but the list of jobs is getting longer by the day. First I am going to divide our lovely snowdrops. Ours are called S. Arnott and are probably the largest snowdrop you can grow. They are much better divided when they are still showing foliage. They die down quite quickly, so mark their whereabouts, and next spring you should get a nice surprise as they don't take long to clump up. This time of year is much better for dividing all grasses, particularly the deciduous types. Don't be tempted to do them in the autumn, although this year would probably have been fine as we have had a very mild, wet winter. I have a large clump of Miscanthus Sinensus "Morning Light" which I am going to divide. This grass is not at all invasive, and with

thin green and white variegated leaves, approimately 4 ft tall, subtley lights up the border for many months. Other deciduous grasses can now be cut back, and if the weather is favourable I shall be cutting back my Penstemon. There should be a nice clump of fresh growth evident at the base. Seed sowing is now well under way. Mild weather sees me emptying the hardier plants out of the cold frames, and putting in the Sweet Peas, Godetia, Clarkia and Sweet Woodruff, which only need a little protection unless we get a very cold spell. Watch out for pests, although at this time of year it is my big feet that do most damage!
