# Local lifeguards awarded for saving man's life

On Wednesday 25th January, the Royal Life Saving Society awarded six lifeguards from Tandridge Leisure Centre in Oxted with the prestigious Meritorious Lifeguard Award for their swift action when 68-year-old Timothy Napier suffered a heart attack while using the fitness pool.

Newly qualified lifeguard, James Lynch, noticed that Mr Napier was lying face down in the water and after blowing his whistle to get his attention and receiving no response, James waded into the water to find the man was semiconscious and unresponsive. On hearing James blow the whistle, other members of the lifeguard team hurried to the poolside to assist him with lifting Mr Napier out of the pool. James then found that Mr Napier had stopped breathing and he was joined by two other Managers, Chris O'Neill and Trina Stravert, who immediately began to administer CPR and and treat Mr Napier with the defibrillator.

After being flown to hospital by air ambulance, Mr Napier was taken straight to theatre where he received a pace-maker.

All the lifeguards who assisted Mr Napier hold RLSS UK's National Pool Lifeguard Qualification (NPLQ), and for newly-qualified James and Kate, this was the first time either of them had dealt with an emergency situation. In total the team performed CPR for 20 minutes.

On Monday 19th December, the team received a visit from Mr Napier who thanked them for their lifesaving intervention. He said he has committed to changing his lifestyle and so far has lost a stone and a half in weight.

On presenting the team with their awards, Helen Bowker,

RLSS UK's Community Drowning Prevention Co-ordinator, said: "On behalf of RLSS UK I'd like to congratulate these six lifeguards on their exceptional bravery and skill. As a

former lifeguard I know how distressing these incidents can be – the fact that two of the lifeguards are newly qualified is a testament to the excellent training they have received."



Anyone wishing to support the appeal can take donations of Easter Eggs or art and craft materials to one of the drop-off points mentioned above.





# Council announces result of community transport review

Following its recent review of community transport, Tan-District . Council ("TDC") have made the decision to award funding to East Surrey Rural Transport Partnership to provide dial-a-ride services across the district. The council's current agreement with East Surrey Dial-a-Ride ("ESDaR") expires on 31st March, so the new service will commence on 3rd April. However, the trustees of ESDaR have unanimously agreed to continue to provide its service to its members, despite failing in its attempt to secure continued funding from TDC.

Speaking about the council's decision to award funding to East Surrey Rural Transport Partnership, Councillor Nick Childs, Chairman of the Community Services Committee, said: "Community transport is an invaluable service for many residents who would otherwise not be able to easily travel around the area. We want to ensure we are providing the best possible service, which also gives value

for money."

A spokesperson for ESDaR "The ESDaR trustees have acknowledged that continuing to provide our much loved and highly valued service without funding from TDC will provide challenges, but due to the incredible generosity of past and present members, we are confident we will be able to continue to provide our current level of service to the most vulnerable members of our community for a considerable period. We will need to establish a fundraising pro-gramme, especially to fund the purchase of replacement vehicles but on the positive side, we feel that being completely independent will enable us to explore additional opportunities regarding the service we provide.

ESDaR continues to welcome new members who, for reasons of age or infirmity, have difficulty in using conventional public transport. For further information call ESDaR Manager, Roger Atkins, on 01883 346547.



# Diary of a Plantaholic

The snowdrops are glorious, and a reminder that it is "all systems go"! And being me, I see everything that needs doing.

Although I have, from experience, tried to prepare for spring since last autumn and through the winter, it is still a fact that there are only a certain number of gardening hours a day. Clearing up of stems and general debris starts in the places I see most. It is still easy to access every part of the borders, but not for much longer, as later bulbs and perennials are coming to life whilst I write. So much damage can be done in my crowded borders if I leave it too late. However, anything slightly tender - Penstemons, Verbena, etc. - are left until later to give them further protection.

Cutting back and feeding the roses is something I've made a good start on. Rose and Clematis food have been bought throughout winter, on special deals, so it isn't too expensive at one time. The Clematis have had a bit of a

tidy up and there is a reasonable amount of growth to show what is alive and what is dead now. I only give a slight tidy up to any of the early flowering Clematis, as a hard prune at the wrong time could seriously diminish flowering.

I could cut back late summer Clematis, but I love them sprawling through my shrubs, so I will do the minimum. Again, access is easy now, though it is surprising how many weeds like to share the Clematis pots, which sit behind the larger shrubs. These Clematis were tiny three to four years ago, but are now full of promise.

Next month some of the tiny plug plants will arrive; seed sowing will be in full swing and I mustn't forget to order nematodes for the vine weevil. Of course there is still time, but I had better put it on my 'to do' list!




